- A.** If you are at Levuka, from Commissioner Eastern, Levuka..
- B.** At Lautoka, from the Commissioner Western Division, Lautoka.
- C.** At Suva, obtainable from the Ministry of Fijian Affairs and Rural Development.
- D.** Once ashore the first person to contact is the Headman, Village Headman or Turagani-Koro.
