Residence Terms & Conditions:

- 1. The holder shall not behave in any manner prejudicial to the peace, defense, public safety order, public morality, public health, security or good government of Fiji Islands.
- 2. If the Principal permit holder and dependents wishes to return permanently to country of citizenship notice must be given to the Permanent Secretary immediately after the decision.
- 3. If the permit holder ceases for any reason to hold a valid permit, the dependent and principal permit shall be deemed to have expired from the date of such cessation.
- 4. If any conditions stated herein is breached by the holder of this permit, the Permanent Secretary will immediately render the permit null and void.
- 5. Principal permit holder and dependents must repatriate immediately to his or her country of citizenship.
- 6. Whilst awaiting repatriation as in clause (5) above, the principal <u>must</u> provide accommodation, meals and other incidentals for themselves until repatriation is executed.
- 7. Repatriation as stated in clause (5) herein should be carried out within 21 working days.
- 8. Should the Principal and Dependent delay or fail to carry out clauses (5) and (6) herein the Principal and Dependent will be deemed to have committed an offence against the Immigration Act and will be subject to a fine of \$20,000.00.
- 9. The same will apply to <u>any other permit holder</u> who breaches a condition stated herein.
- 10. Signatures below is to be witnessed by Commissioner of Oaths, Notary Public or Justice of Peace.
